Looking back on 2020

It was a busy start to 2020 with the team collaborating with our clients on some innovative new labels. A longstanding honey client made use of one of our Authenticote Security features, incorporating a foil image with a nano emboss as a security feature on their label.

The nano emboss creates incredibly fine textures in the foil images which makes it difficult for counterfeiters to recreate. It's important to protect your brand, and Rapid has a number of security features that can help with this.



The team were also busy in January preparing for our ISO Accreditation Audit which we passed with flying colours. We received Telarc certification for our Quality, Environmental and Health and Safety Management Systems. Recognition that our systems in these three key areas of business are robust.


